

IEEE Computer Society Student Scholarship

The Merwin scholarship was created in honor of the late Richard E. Merwin, past president of the society, to recognize and reward active leaders in the IEEE Computer Society student branch chapters who show promise in their academic and professional efforts. The selected winners of this award will have the opportunity to serve as IEEE CS Student Ambassadors for the particular IEEE region to which they belong. Duties as Student Ambassadors will include collecting and disseminating information to all IEEE CS student chapters in their region and serving as a liaison between the Member and Geographic Activities Board (MGAB) and the IEEE CS student members in their region.

Scholarships up to \$2000

Over a dozen scholarships of up to \$2,000 each are available, for one academic year. Deadline for submission is October 31st of each year.

Who is eligible

Graduate students, juniors, and seniors in electrical or computer engineering, computer science, information technology, or a well-defined computer related field who are active members of a Computer Society student branch chapter are eligible. Applicants are required to have a minimum grade point average of 2.5 over 4.0, and be a full-time student as defined by his or her academic institution during the course of the award.
