The Region 8 Nominations and Appointments (N&A)
Subcommittee shall identify qualified candidates for elected and appointed positions of Region 8 and its Committees including candidates for the Director-Elect slate.

N&A Subcommittee shall:

Submit to the Board of Directors, after the approval of the R8 Committee, a slate of at least two and not more than three candidates for Region 8 Director-Elect. In the case of the election process involving more than one candidate, the Region 8 N&A Subcommittee slate of candidates, including biographies and position statements, shall be made available to all members of the Region 8 Committee at least twenty-eight days (28) before the Region 8 Committee meeting at which the election shall take place or the slate approved. The order of names for each position will be randomised.

- 15 July information about slates/candidates sent to R8 Committee members
- 18 August (R8 Committee meeting)
 - approval of the slate of the candidates for 2013-2014 Director-Elect
 - elections of 2012 R8 Vice Chairs

Saurabh Sinha completed his B.Eng degree (with distinction), M.Eng degree (with distinction) and PhD (Eng) degree from the University of Pretoria, South Africa. He is also employed by the University of Pretoria. Prof. Sinha's activities include research, undergraduate and postgraduate training. Saurabh pursues and manages research in the field of microelectronics (radio-frequency integrated circuits (ICs) and mm-Wave ICs), where he has also authored or co-authored some 40 publications in peer-reviewed international conferences and journals.

Saurabh is the managing editor of the only locally accredited journal of electrical engineering in South Africa, the SAIEE Africa Research Journal. Saurabh also serves as an industrial consultant for Business Enterprises at University of Pretoria (Pty) Ltd. Saurabh is registered to practise as a professional engineer with the Engineering Council of South Africa (ECSA). ECSA is a signatory of the Washington Accord. In 2007, Saurabh received the South African Institute of Electrical Engineers' Engineer of the Year award. Most recently, Saurabh became a recipient of the 2010 University of Pretoria Laureate award, the most esteemed alumni award.
