- A non personal IEEE email alias that forwards to an individual or more. Available for: Regions, Sections, Chapters, Students Branches
- Enables you to contact a specific service from IEEE without having to know the specific person responsible
- Can be used on IEEE's WebPages as a contact for a service, making the WebPages simpler to maintain (e.g cyprus@ieee.org)

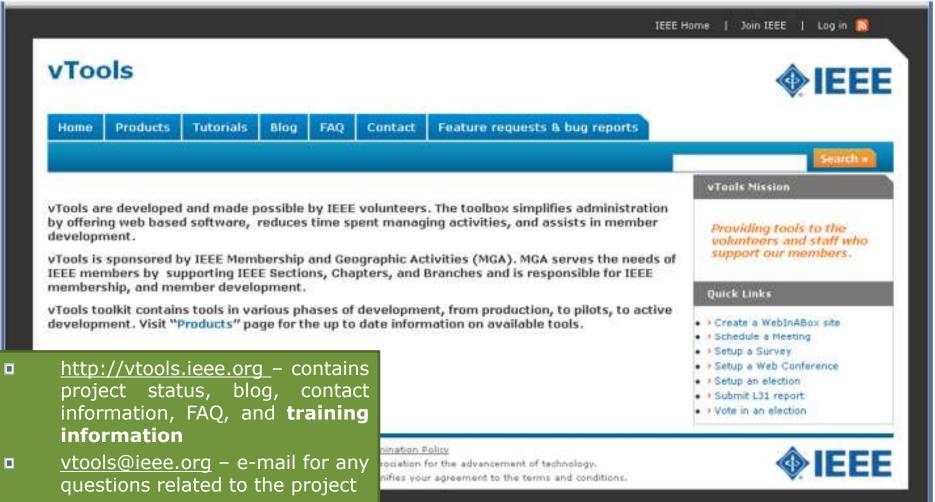

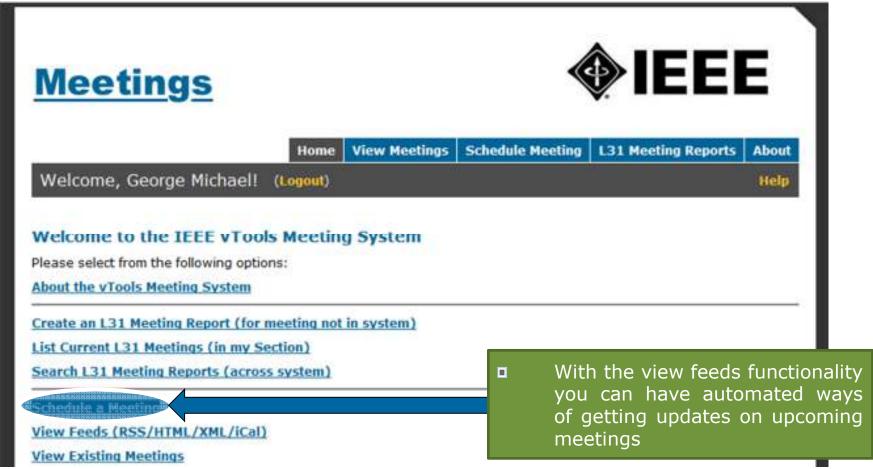

Topic: The Green Flash: A Low-Power Supercomputer For Climate Modeling

Biography: Michael Wehner, Lenny Oliker, and John Shalf work at Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory. Oliker and Shalf have backgrounds in computer science and electrical engineering, as you might expect for members of a team proposing a supercomputer for modeling climate change-"A Real Cloud Computer". Wehner, however, was trained in nuclear physics and designed bombs before switching to climate research. Their supercomputer idea is now being taken seriously, but when Wehner first proposed it at a 2008 conference, even he felt it was fanciful. "I was prepared to be laughed off the stage," he recalls.


